PRESIDENT'S WELCOME

Dear Members and Guests,

On behalf of the Scientific Program Committee and the SGS Board of Directors, welcome to the 52nd Annual Scientific Meeting in Phoenix!

We have an exciting program crafted by Scientific Program Committee, led by Chair, Dr. Peter Jeppson. The theme for this year's meeting, Advancing Gynecological Surgery: Growth Through Adaptability and Accessibility addresses timely topics that we face as gynecologic surgeons, including artificial intelligence, gynecologic surgeon workforce projections, access to care and variation in the procedures we offer for our patients.

The format of the meeting will continue in the SGS tradition, with most abstracts and presentations in a common session without concurrent sessions. We continue to feel that this is part of the way to preserve what Past President, Vivian Sung coined as "the special sauce" of SGS. Each of the twenty selected oral presentations will have a discussant.

On Sunday, March 22, 2026, the meeting kicks off with three Post-Graduate Courses:

8-12 noon: Moderated by Anna Zelivianskaia, MD, FACOG Young Attending Course 2026: "Teaching and Billing and Marketing: Oh My!" (Non-CME) This course aims to lay the foundation for young attendings to envision and develop a surgical practice after a benign gynecology surgical fellowship. The target audience will include trainees and recent graduates of Minimally Invasive Gynecologic Surgery and Urogynecology and Reproductive Pelvic Surgery fellowships.

1-5 pm: "Sharpening Skills, Shaping Practice: Advances in Teaching Gynecologic Surgery" Course Director: Sara Wood, MD, MHPE Faculty: Katherine de Souza, MD, Rajiv Gala, MD & Sarin Abiola Soyemi, MD. Designed for junior and senior faculty surgical educators involved in resident and fellow training, the course will explore practical

tools such as simulation-based learning and gaming, structured feedback models, and progressive entrustment frameworks that promote operative preparedness and learner autonomy.

1-5 pm: "Billing & Coding in Gynecologic Surgery" Course Director: Marc Toglia, MD Faculty: Jon Hathaway, MD, PhD, FACOG, FACS & Mitch Schuster, MD. This course is designed to equip gynecologists, urogynecologists, fellows, and coding professionals with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to navigate the complex landscape of billing and coding in gynecologic surgery.

The main scientific program kicks off on Monday with an exciting array of speakers, including:

- SGS Spotlight #1 C. T. Lin, MD, Chief Medical Information Officer, University Colorado Health. "I'm Sorry Dave, I'm Afraid I Can't Do That: Using Artificial Intelligence in Clinical Care." Dr. Lin is an expert on artificial intelligence (AI) and recent applications to clinical practice. He even promises to bring his ukulele to his presentation!
- Mark D. Walters, MD Annual Lecture: Sharon Malone, MD, "Menopause 101 - All Things Perimenopause and Menopause." A passionate advocate for women's midlife health, Dr. Malone addresses gaps in healthcare, racial disparities, and the stigma surrounding menopause. She is the New York Times bestselling author of "Grown Woman Talk: Your Guide to Getting and Staying Healthy (2024)", a practical resource empowering women to navigate healthcare and advocate for themselves. Dr. Malone is a frequent media contributor, keynote speaker, and host of the podcast The Second Opinion with Dr. Sharon.
- Panel Discussion - Contemplating Workforce Shortages, Access to Care, and Surgical Deserts in Gynecologic Specialty Care. Moderator: Kimberly Kenton, MD Speakers: Rajiv Gala, MD, Denise Howard, MD, MPH, Thomas Tsai, MD, MPH & Fidel Valea, MD

- Equity Council Address: Sandra E. Brooks, MD, MBA, Chief Executive Officer, American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology (ACOG). We are honored to have Dr. Brooks as our keynote speaker for the Equity Council during our annual President's Awards Ceremony. Her title, "The Future of OB GYN Care: A Case for Collective Action", is timely in our current environment. As most of you know, under Dr. Brooks' leadership, ACOG in August 2025 announced that it would stop accepting federal funding for all programs, citing misalignment with federal policy changes.

Tuesday early risers are invited to join others for breakfast learning in the Innovation Simulation Room. Come see five presentations in an open "viewing" hour, talk with those presenting and vote for your favorite presentation!

Other featured speakers for Tuesday include:

- SGS Spotlight #2: Cara King, DO, MS. "Surgical Coaching" Dr. King is the former course director for the SGS Winter PG Course and is currently President of the Academy of Surgical Coaching. She inspires us with her energy and passion for surgery and surgical coaching.
- Richard W. TeLinde Lecture: John O. L. DeLancey, MD. Dr. DeLancey will present, "True Confessions of a Surgeon-Scientist." A Past President of SGS, Dr. DeLancey is the Norman F. Miller Professor of Gynecology and Professor of Urology at the University of Michigan. He has spent the last four decades in the operating room and conducting research trying to identify the structural and functional failures that cause pelvic floor disorders, how those affect surgical outcomes and how birth causes these injuries

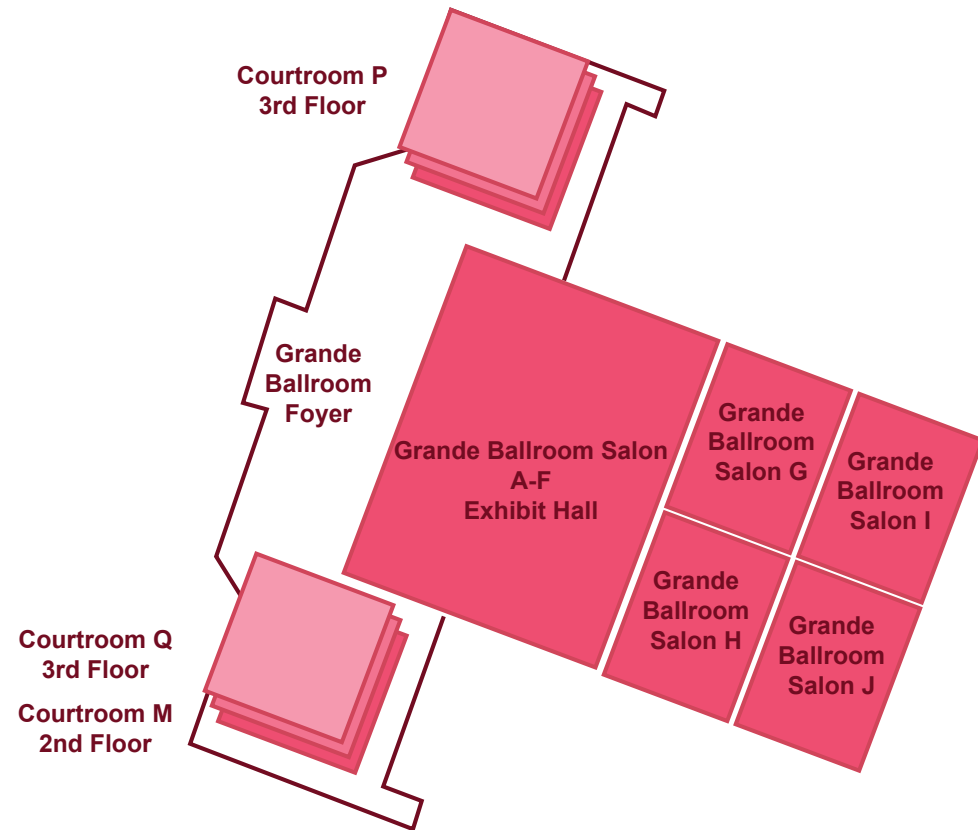

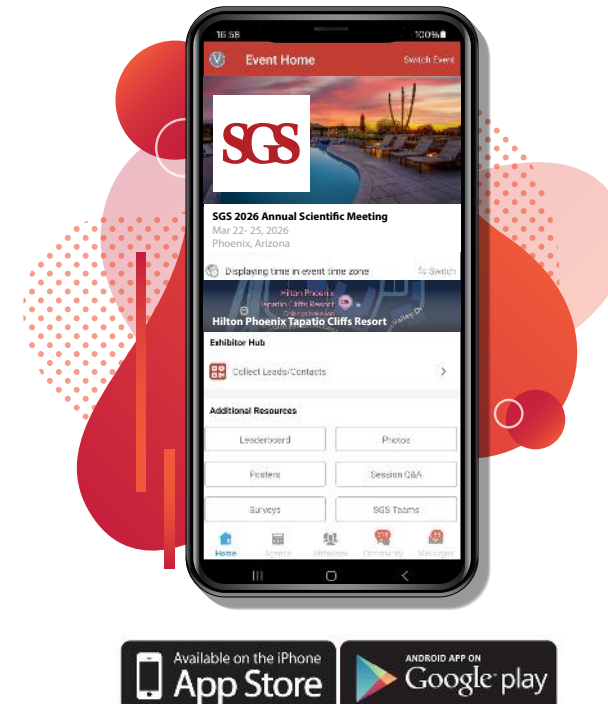

Dr. Sandra Brooks is a distinguished physician leader and healthcare executive whose career reflects an unwavering commitment to advancing health equity, quality, and innovation in obstetrics and gynecology. A Phi Beta Kappa and Alpha Omega Alpha graduate of Howard University's College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and College of Medicine, Dr. Brooks completed her residency in obstetrics and gynecology at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania and a fellowship in gynecologic oncology at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston. Her clinical career began at the University of Massachusetts, followed by her appointment as Director of the Division of Gynecologic Oncology at the University of Maryland, where she rose to the rank of full professor. During this time, she earned an MBA in Medical Services Management from Johns Hopkins University.

Dr. Brooks transitioned to physician executive and Chief Medical Officer roles in diverse healthcare settings across Kentucky, New Jersey, Florida, and Pennsylvania. In these roles, she spearheaded transformative initiatives focused on patient safety, quality improvement, and health equity, leading multidisciplinary teams in community, nonprofit, and academic environments.

In August 2024, Dr. Brooks assumed the role of Chief Executive Officer of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), a premier membership organization representing more than 60,000 professionals dedicated to improving obstetric and gynecologic care. As CEO, she is driving strategic initiatives that include modernizing residency applications, training and continuing education, advocating for the protection of the patient-physician relationship, and advancing programs that promote practice sustainability, leadership development, clinical guidance, and physician wellness.

Dr. Brooks' career exemplifies visionary leadership, clinical excellence, and a steadfast dedication to improving the lives of patients, families, and communities.

Menopause 101 - All Things Perimenopause and Menopause

Dr. Sharon Malone is a New York Times bestselling author, women's health advocate, podcast host and Chief Medical Advisor at Alloy Health. A board-certified OB/GYN and Certified Menopause Practitioner, she spent nearly 30 years in private practice before dedicating her career to expanding access to evidence-based menopause care and closing the gender gap in midlife health.

Her groundbreaking book, *Grown Woman Talk*, and appearances on *The Oprah Winfrey Show*, *The Michelle Obama Podcast*, *CBS Sunday Morning*, *Today Show* and more has made her one of the most visible voices advancing women's health today. In 2025, she served as the keynote speaker for the ACOG national convention, spoke at *EssenceFest* and was honored on the 2024 *Forbes 50 Over 50* list. A proud sister of *Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.*, she is a charter member of the *Xi Tau Chapter (Cambridge, MA)*, which recently celebrated its 45th anniversary.

Her newest endeavor, *The Second Opinion with Dr. Sharon*, is a weekly podcast where women take back the conversation on health with straight talk, real experience, and the care we all deserve. Alongside high-profile advocates, experts, and patients, Dr. Malone tackles the questions women have been conditioned to ignore, from dismissed symptoms and gaps in healthcare to family hardships, menopause, and emerging health issues. Each episode concludes with "Doctor's Orders," bite-sized takeaways designed to empower women with tools to advocate for themselves and each other. No sugarcoating. No waiting rooms. Just the truth, finally.

John O. L. DeLancey, MD is the Norman F. Miller Professor of Gynecology and Professor of Urology at the University of Michigan. He has spent the last 4 decades in the operating room and conducting research trying to identify the structural and functional failures that cause pelvic floor disorders, how those affect surgical outcomes and how birth causes these injuries. He has published more than 350 scientific articles, received over \$32 million in NIH funding, and lectured in 30 countries on 6 continents. In recognition of this pioneering work, he was elected to the National Academy of Medicine and named an Honorary Fellow ad eundem in the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. A former President of the American Urogynecologic Society, Society of Gynecologic Surgeons and American Gynecological and Obstetrical Society he is listed in *Best Doctors in America* and has received *Marquis Who's Who in the World Life-time Achievement Award*.

Dr. Tsai's research bridges healthcare delivery and public health to inform the design and implementation of innovative care delivery models.

Dr. Tsai has had an ongoing commitment to public service. He served as Senior Policy Advisor to the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in the Obama Administration. He served as Senior Policy Advisor for the COVID-19 Response to the Biden Administration and Testing and Treatment Coordinator on the White House COVID-19 Response Team. He advises the CDC Office of Readiness and Response and is a consulting member of the FDA Digital Health Advisory Committee. Dr. Tsai has led strategic healthcare initiatives in the private sector, serving as Chief Medical Advisor for Ginkgo Biosecurity. Dr. Tsai continues to further the resilience of the US healthcare delivery system strategic advisory council member of the Common Health Coalition.

His research has been featured in national media outlets and has been published in the New England Journal of Medicine, JAMA, Lancet, Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, Nature Communications, Health Affairs, Annals of Surgery, and JAMA Surgery. He serves on the editorial board for Annals of Surgery and Health Services Research. Dr. Tsai is a graduate of Harvard College, Stanford University School of Medicine, and Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.

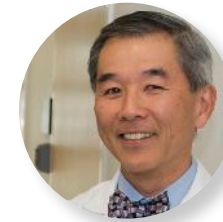

Fidel Valea, MD, most recently served as Professor and System Chief of Gynecologic Oncology for the Northwell Health Cancer Institute / Zucker School of Medicine. He was born in Havana, Cuba, and raised in NYC where he earned a BS in Biomedical Engineering from Columbia University School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, before completing medical school at the State University of New York at Stony Brook. He completed both his Residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as Fellowship in Gynecologic Oncology at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. Doctor Valea then joined the faculty at Stony Brook in 1992, where he became the Residency Program Director, PI for the GOG, as well as the Director of the Division of Gynecologic Oncology during his 12-year tenure. He joined the faculty at Duke in 2004, and during his 12 years there he was promoted to a full-tenured Professor and served as the Vice-Chair of Education, Residency Program Director in Obstetrics and Gynecology, as well as the Fellowship Director in Gynecologic Oncology until 2016 when he left Duke to become the Chairman of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine. He served as the chair for 5 years before joining the faculty at Northwell. Doctor Valea is a member of several organizations including the Society of Gynecologic Oncology, ACOG, and ABOG previously serving on the Board of Directors for all three organizations as well as the Director of Gynecologic Oncology for ABOG. He also served as chairman of ACOG's task force on levels of Gynecologic Care. He has won numerous national and regional teaching awards and has more than 100 peer-reviewed publications, online articles, and book chapters. Doctor Valea is one of four editors for the recent edition of Comprehensive Gynecology. His research interests include surgical education, minimally invasive surgery, and evidence-based perioperative care. His professional passion is medical education at all levels.

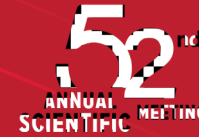

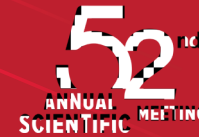

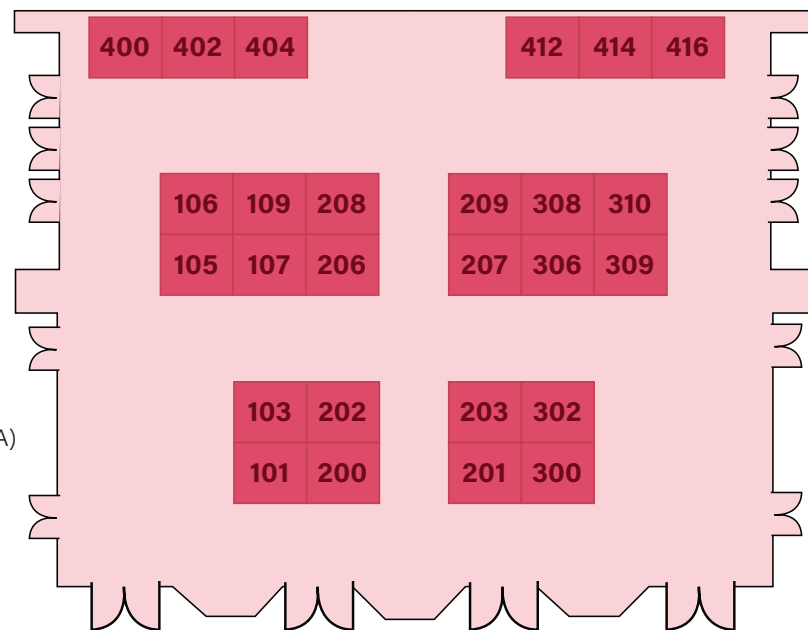
